

Changes to KIDMED Enrollment Process for Out of State Providers:
(For Hurricane Katrina)

- Provider obtains Basic Enrollment Packet (revised for emergency enrollment due to Hurricane Katrina) from Provider Relations; Provider Enrollment; or online at www.lamedicaid.com.
 - There are two “emergency” Basic Enrollment Packets online: one for those providers who **are** currently enrolled in their state Medicaid Program; and one for those who **are not** already enrolled in their state Medicaid Program.
- Provider completes the enrollment packet and faxes it back to Provider Enrollment at one of three numbers listed in the packets. Out of state providers enrolling for KIDMED services will not have a site certification done by ACS/KIDMED.
- Provider Enrollment will add Claim Type 13 to provider file indicating the provider is allowed to bill and be reimbursed for KIDMED services and will notify provider by telephone and by mail of their enrollment in LA Medicaid.
- Provider Enrollment will forward a copy of the enrollment form to Brian Bagdan in Program Operations office who will notify Laurie Terrell at ACS/KIDMED office to complete the process with regards to Subsystem Provider files.
- LA Medicaid Provider enrollment will be granted for 90 days using this process. If the provider wishes to remain a LA Medicaid provider for longer than this time they must complete a regular Medicaid enrollment packet.
