SUBJECT: Louisiana Medicaid Pharmacy Point of Sale (POS) Dispensing Fees for

Maintenance Medications

Effective April 1, 2022, the Louisiana Medicaid Fee for Service (FFS) Pharmacy Program will implement a Point of Sale educational alert for pharmacy claims for select maintenance medications. The POS educational alert applies to pharmacy claims submitted to FFS only. The purpose of the alert is to limit the Fee for Service professional dispensing fee (DF) to a maximum of one dispensing fee per identified maintenance drug and strength per rolling thirty days.

Educational Alert for Maintenance Medications

The educational edit will alert pharmacies when they are submitting pharmacy claims for medications identified by First Data Bank as a maintenance medication that is not dispensed in at least a 30 day supply, in accordance to FFS Pharmacy Program policy. If a Generic/Brand product and strength has been dispensed for at least 60 days, and the current pharmacy claim is for the same Generic/Brand product and strength and is **NOT** dispensed in a 30 day supply, then an educational alert will be sent. The dispensing fee will not be reimbursed and the following message will be sent at Point of Sale (POS):

FFS Only: NCPDP rejection code 19 (M/I Days Supply) mapped to

EOB code 301 One Dispensing Fee per 30 Days for Maintenance

Medications.

Note: The pharmacy will still be reimbursed for the ingredient cost on each dispensing.

Override: Upon consultation with the prescriber to verify the necessity of the short fill (quantity less than 30 days' supply), the pharmacist may override the claim and be reimbursed the dispensing fee by submitting the following override at POS:

NCPDP field 420-DK: Submission Clarification Code (SCC) value of 47 – Shortened Days' Supply Fill.
