SUBJECT: End of Public Health Emergency (PHE) for COVID-19 Pharmacy Updates

The Department of Health and Human Services will end the Public Health Emergency (PHE) for COVID-19, declared under Section 319 of the Public Health Service Act. The Louisiana Medicaid Pharmacy Program, which consists of Fee for Service (FFS) Medicaid and MCOs (Aetna, AmeriHealth Caritas, Healthy Blue, Humana Healthy Horizons, Louisiana Healthcare Connections, and UnitedHealthcare) will make the following changes.

The pharmacy PHE will unwind in phases.
