Shared Plans and Legacy Medicaid Policy Change Notice

Maximum Daily Dosage Limit for Iloperidone (Fanapt®) for Recipients in Bayou Health Shared Plans and Legacy Medicaid

Effective February 20, 2014 prescriptions for Iloperidone (Fanapt®) will have a maximum daily dosage limit of 24 mg/day. Claims which exceed the maximum daily dosage limit will deny through Point of Sale (POS) with:

NCPDP rejection code 88 (DUR Reject Error) mapped to

EOB Code 529 (Exceeds maximum daily dose).

If the prescribing practitioner chooses to exceed the maximum daily dosage limit, the prescribing practitioner must provide the reason why the maximum daily dosage limit needs to be exceeded. The pharmacist may override the dosage limit <u>after consultation</u> with the prescriber. The pharmacist must document on the hardcopy prescription or in the pharmacy's electronic recordkeeping system (1) the prescriber's reason why the maximum daily dosage limit needs to be exceeded, and (2) the NCPDP DUR override codes used in submitting the claim.

The pharmacist must submit the override at the Point of Sale in:

NCPDP 439-E4 field (Reason for Service Code) - HD (High Dose)

NCPDP 440-E5 field (Professional Service Code) - MØ (Prescriber Consulted)

NCPDP 441-E6 field (Result of Service Code) - 1G (Filled with Prescriber Approval)
